

solar bike retro fit bicycle race



Saturday 21st November 12 pm (11:30am registration)

Please come, spread the word and join the first Perth underground retro-fit bike race. This is for riders of any bicycle as well as for riders who have retro-fitted their bicycle with additional electric power. The race is competitive for those wishing to compete and friendly for those who wish to enjoy a leisurely ride. Competitors must pay \$5 and the winner takes all. No fee for non-competitors. Registration of riders is at 11:30 am. The start time is 12pm. However, the following handicaps apply in terms of minutes headstart for all riders (add all handicaps that apply):

Non-power assisted bike and non-carbon fibre bike - 2 min

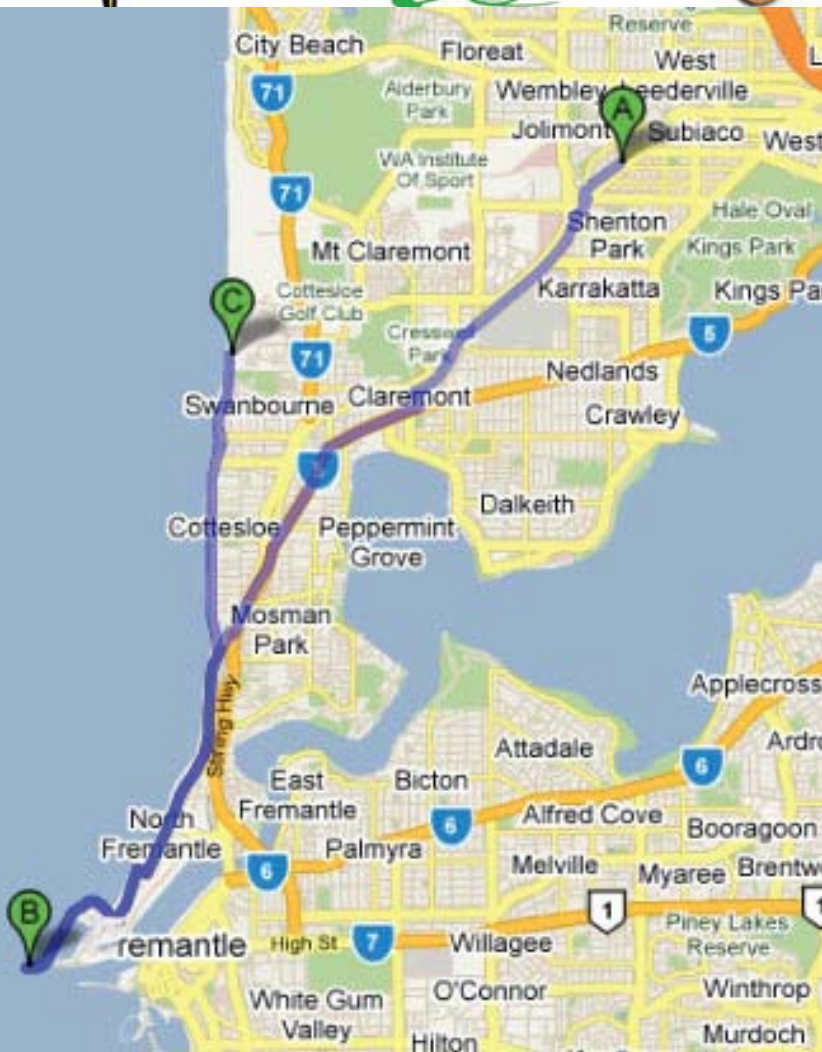
Bikes with 26" rims or smaller - 2 min

The smarter sex (females) - 2 min

Aged over 50 - 3 min, over 60 - 4 min, over 70 - 5 min

eg. a 75 year old lady riding a mountain bike would get an 11 min headstart and begin riding at 11:49 am

The race will begin at Daglish station (assemble here at 11:30am) and will follow the bicycle track along the train railway all the way down to cottesloe, where it comes out onto the West Coast HWY. Follow this HWY all the way down to leighton beach and then hug the ocean road all the way until you get to the North Fremantle lighthouse, go around the lighthouse and then turn around and follow the beach road all the way to the end, which will take you to Swanbourne surf life saving club. Any shortcuts you can find or traffic lights you ride through are all part of the race! You'll probably be hot after the race so bring some swimmers for a lovely cool dip in the ocean.
